Safety Information

- Balloons undergo regular maintenance and comprehensive safety inspections.
- Flights operate only under favorable weather conditions and may be postponed or rescheduled if conditions are unsuitable.
- A detailed safety briefing is provided before every flight.
- Passengers must follow all instructions from the pilot and ground crew throughout the experience.



Age & Health Requirements

- Suitable for children aged 5 years and above (children must be accompanied by an adult).
- Pregnant women are generally not permitted to fly.
- Not recommended for guests with serious heart conditions, recent surgeries, severe back or neck injuries, or mobility limitations that could make takeoff or landing difficult.
- If you have any medical concerns, consult your physician before booking

Best Time to Fly

The best season for hot air ballooning in Pokhara is from September to May, when the skies are generally clear and mountain visibility is at its best. Sunrise and sunset flights offer the most spectacular scenery and ideal weather conditions

Weather Policy

Hot air balloon flights are highly weather-dependent. In the event of strong winds, rain, poor visibility, or other unsafe conditions, the flight will be rescheduled or refunded according to the operator's cancellation policy.
