TOUR INTRODUCTION

This six-day two-country journey begins with Singapore's city landmarks and Sentosa Island before continuing by coach to Kuala Lumpur for capital-city sightseeing, Batu Caves, and a full-day Genting Highlands excursion. The package combines urban attractions, cultural stops, shopping, a scenic intercity road journey, and highland leisure. Airport assistance, coach tickets, hotel transfers, and local sightseeing are coordinated under the confirmed quotation.

Singapore | Two-night city stay

Singapore combines Marina Bay's skyline, multicultural neighborhoods, gardens, efficient transport, shopping, food culture, and family attractions. Sentosa adds beaches and entertainment to the city stay.

Kuala Lumpur

Malaysia | Three-night capital stay

Kuala Lumpur blends the Petronas Twin Towers, royal and civic landmarks, mosques, markets, shopping centers, and varied Malay, Chinese, and Indian influences.



Batu Caves and Genting Highlands

Malaysia | Full-day excursion

Batu Caves is a major Hindu pilgrimage and cultural site set within limestone formations. Genting Highlands offers cooler temperatures, mountain scenery, resorts, shopping, and entertainment outside Kuala Lumpur.

DETAILED DAY-WISE ITINERARY

DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN SINGAPORE

Overnight: Singapore | Airport assistance and hotel transfer

Arrive at Singapore's designated airport, complete entry formalities, meet the local representative, and transfer to the confirmed hotel. The remainder of the day is free to rest or explore nearby areas independently.

Planned Experience:

- Meet-and-greet assistance at the airport
- Air-conditioned transfer to the Singapore hotel
- Hotel check-in according to standard timing

DAY 03: COACH TRANSFER TO KUALA LUMPUR

Check out after breakfast and transfer to the designated coach terminal for the scheduled journey to Kuala Lumpur. Complete border and immigration formalities en route, then transfer or proceed to the confirmed hotel after arrival. The evening is free.

Explore Kuala Lumpur's major civic, cultural, and modern landmarks during the confirmed city tour. The route may include photo stops around the Petronas Twin Towers, King's Palace, National Mosque, Independence Square, and other selected districts.

- Guided or driver-led Kuala Lumpur city orientation
- Selected civic and cultural landmarks
- Petronas Twin Towers exterior photo stop when included
- Return to the hotel with free time for shopping or dining

DAY 05: BATU CAVES & GENTING HIGHLANDS

Overnight: Kuala Lumpur | Full-day excursion | Meals: breakfast

After breakfast, travel toward Genting Highlands with a visit to Batu Caves according to the confirmed route. Continue to the highland resort area for cooler weather, scenic views, shopping, attractions, or independent leisure before returning to Kuala Lumpur.

- Batu Caves cultural and photo stop
- Journey into the Genting Highlands
- Free time for confirmed attractions, shopping, or leisure

DAY 06: DEPARTURE FROM KUALA LUMPUR

Tour conclusion | Airport transfer | Meals: breakfast when timing permits

Check out and transfer to Kuala Lumpur International Airport for the onward flight. Pickup time follows the confirmed airline schedule, traffic, airport terminal, and required reporting time.

BOOKING AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

- **Initial booking:** A clear color scan of the passport information page and traveler details must be provided for ticket, hotel, transport, and visa or entry processing.
- **Passport validity:** The passport should normally remain valid for at least six months beyond the travel date and contain sufficient blank pages; travelers must confirm the rule applicable to them.
- **Deposit:** A 50% advance is normally required to issue tickets and begin supplier or visa processing unless the invoice states a different schedule.
- **Visa and entry documents:** Photographs, financial evidence, employment or sponsorship documents, confirmed bookings, and other materials may be requested for Singapore and Malaysia according to nationality and authority requirements.
- **Entry formalities:** Travelers must complete any digital arrival forms, declarations, permits, or health requirements in force at the time of travel.
- **Authority decision:** Visa and entry decisions are made solely by embassies, immigration departments, and border officers; approval cannot be guaranteed by the travel company.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

IMPORTANT TRAVEL NOTES

1. Booking Confirmation

No booking is held until written confirmation and the required deposit are received. Airfare, hotel, cruise, train, attraction, and visa-service availability can change before confirmation.

2. Price Basis

The package price is based on the quoted travel dates, group size, room-sharing basis, service category, and currency. Single, child, and infant rates are provided on request.



3. Payment

The invoice will state the deposit, balance deadline, payment method, and bank charges. Failure to pay by the deadline may result in cancellation or repricing.

4. Visa and Entry Processing

Visa or entry processing begins only after complete documents and required payment are received. Fees and processing charges are non-refundable once submitted, including when an application is refused or delayed.

5. Tickets and Transport

Issued air, rail, coach, cruise, and attraction tickets follow the supplier's name, date-change, baggage, refund, and no-show rules. Penalties and fare differences apply separately from land-package terms.

6. Cancellation

Cancellation must be made in writing. Charges follow the confirmed quotation and actual supplier commitments, including non-refundable visa, airline, hotel, cruise, rail, coach, transfer, and attraction costs. No refund is normally available for unused services after departure.

7. Changes and Customization

The itinerary may be customized before confirmation at additional cost. Changes after confirmation remain subject to availability, supplier fees, and fare differences.

8. Operational Changes

The order, timing, route, pickup, vehicle, hotel, vessel, train, attraction, or activity may be adjusted because of traffic, weather, transport operation, closure, safety, or other conditions. Comparable alternatives will be arranged where reasonably possible.

9. Hotels and Rooms

Standard check-in is generally in the afternoon and check-out around midday, but property rules vary. Early check-in, late check-out, bedding, connecting rooms, room views, and upgrades are subject to availability unless confirmed in writing.

10. Traveler Responsibility

Travelers must carry valid passports, visas, entry approvals, tickets, insurance, and funds; follow local laws and attraction rules; and report on time for all flights, trains, coaches, boats, transfers, and tours.

11. Insurance and Health

Comprehensive travel insurance is strongly recommended. Travelers must disclose mobility, medical, dietary, or accessibility needs before booking and assess whether optional activities are suitable for them.

12. Acceptance

Payment of the deposit or written confirmation signifies acceptance of the final itinerary, quotation, inclusions, exclusions, supplier rules, cancellation policy, and these terms and conditions.



IMPORTANT TRAVEL NOTES

- Carry passports, visas or entry approvals, coach tickets, hotel vouchers, insurance details, and emergency contacts in printed and digital form.
- Travelers must independently satisfy both Singapore and Malaysia entry requirements applicable to their nationality.
- Coach travel requires punctual reporting and may involve carrying luggage through border formalities.
- Dress modestly at Batu Caves and religious sites; stairs and uneven surfaces may require suitable footwear.
- Sentosa and Genting attraction tickets remain subject to operating schedules, maintenance, capacity, and weather.
